Dear Ms. Gray:

This office has completed its review of the disciplinary complaint that you filed against Suzanne R. Folsom, Esquire. You state that Ms. Folsom, while employed as Director of the Department of Institutional Integrity, created a hostile work environment for employees, abused her use of discretion concerning certain matters, and engaged in the unfair treatment and due process of others during the review process.

Upon review, we do not find sufficient evidence to support your allegations of disciplinary misconduct warranting a formal investigation. While we do not condone the conduct that you describe, we do not find that Ms. Folsom's alleged improper conduct as a manager/employer/supervisor is a violation of the ethical rules. Absent a finding of dishonesty or other disciplinary Rule violation by a tribunal, we decline to proceed with our inquiry and have closed our file.

We thank you for bringing your concerns to our attention.
